

Walsh Road Area - Proposed Emergency Evacuation Routes (Draft-Version 3)

The Menlo Park Fire Protection District has been leading a project to establish Emergency Evacuation Routes for the Walsh Road Neighborhood in case of fire, flood or other emergency. The Walsh Road CERT Committee has been heavily involved in this effort. Below you see the routes proposed and somewhat usable at this time. Some notes: 1) The main evacuation route for the area remains Walsh Road to the Alameda. (Designated ——) 2) The main secondary auto route in an emergency will be the road through the water company connecting to Moore Road. The water company has to open the gate at the entrance of the road for this to be passable. (Designated ——) 3) There are pedestrian exits by using the horse tunnel under 280 and by following the end of Valley Road up past 60 Valley Court to get on Moore Road (*Private Property*). (Designated ——) 4) It is possible to “4 wheel” over the exit past 60 Valley Road to exit to Moore Road (*Private Property*). (Designated ——)
